GENERAL EDUCATION FIRST-YEAR WRITING REQUIREMENT

Approved Courses for Students Admitted or Readmitted Prior to Fall 2015

Complete English (ENGL) 110, Introduction to Academic Writing, or one of the approved course credit combinations satisfying the first-year writing general education requirement.

Approved Courses and Course Credit Combinations

English (ENGL) 110 or Honors (HONS) 110

OR

English (ENGL) 101* AND English (ENGL) 102*

OR

English (ENGL) 101* AND English (ENGL) 215

OR

English (ENGL) 101* AND English (ENGL) 110 or Honors (HONS) 110

OR

English (ENGL) 101* AND an approved portfolio**

OR

International Baccalaureate (IB) exam score of 6 or higher AND an approved portfolio**

OR

English (ENGL) 102* AND English (ENGL) 110 or Honors (HONS) 110

OR

English (ENGL) 102* AND English (ENGL) 215

Note: Students are expected to complete the first-year writing requirement within the first year of enrollment.
