There are many things that contributed to the failure of the EIS at Genericorp. Some of them are interrelated. A list of reasons include:

- 1. No clear business need for the EIS.
- 2. A reliance on the vendor's demo to garner support.
- 3. Weak executive sponsorship.
- 4. Lack of executive involvement in the development process.
- 5. Lack of executive commitment and ownership of the system.
- 6. Poorly defined information requirements.
- 7. The EIS provided little value added over existing reporting systems.
- 8. Reassigning the original development team.
- 9. Placing the EIS in maintenance mode.
- 10. Having inappropriate and poorly prepared personnel take over the EIS.
- 11. Failure to expand the system's content and user base.
- 12. Failure to promote the system.
